

Sydney

The Rocks and Circular Quay

It's all about the city sights with beautiful water frontage. Right on the water, you'll stand in the shade of Sydney Opera House and the equally iconic Sydney Harbour Bridge. In the heart of the city, this is the place to go for markets, galleries, great shopping, restaurants and bars. Seek out treasures among cobblestone laneways and sandstone warehouses and have a drink in an old pub before taking a ferry from Circular Quay across to Manly or Taronga Zoo.

Darling Harbour

Be spoilt for choice at Darling Harbour. Alive with activity day and night, there's always something happening and always plenty to see. Find Nemo at the Sydney Aquarium or head to Sydney Wildlife World and pat a koala. The area is packed with attractions and you can see it all from the city's monorail.

Eating your way around Darling Harbour is highly recommended. Find everything from steak houses to fine dining at Cockle Bay Wharf or King Street Wharf before heading out to a club nearby. There's usually a host of free entertainment to be had outside, too. Street performers and live music add to the spectacle along the waterfront. Darling Harbour is simply bustling with things to do.

City

It's all about shopping, dining and enjoying Sydney's outdoor lifestyle in the city centre. The holy trinity of holiday fun can be found in a huge variety of attractions, sensational restaurants and large gardens where you can while away the hours amid the bustling metropolis. When it comes time for some retail therapy Sydney dishes it out in spades. The Queen Victoria Building fills an entire city block and there are more than four hundred stores along Pitt Street Mall.

Inner East

Ready to up the ante? Sydney's inner east oozes with style and is packed with restaurants and fashion boutiques. Enjoy lunch before shopping up a storm on Oxford Street, Paddington. Darlinghurst and Surry Hills are restaurant central, or head out to Woolloomooloo for an afternoon bite along the waterfront at Finger Wharf. Kings Cross will have you swept up in the nightlife – there's something for everyone here!

East Sydney

City meets surf in a cornucopia of famous beaches and harbourside suburbs east of Sydney. Whatever your style, you're bound to find it here.

Take advantage of the exclusive cafés, bars, boutiques and beauty salons in upmarket Double Bay. From upmarket to free and easy, Bondi is the closest surf beach to the city and its famous sandy stretch is the Sydney playground where everyone from board riders to billionaires come to mingle. At the southern end of the stretch, surf's up at Coogee. The classic Sydney surf beach has walking tracks and is a popular, quieter spot to relax.

North Sydney

If you prefer a little more city than surf, harbourside suburbs Cremorne and the exclusive McMahons Point tick all the boxes. The area is renowned for fabulous stylish restaurants and boutiques, or spend some time at nearby Taronga Zoo.

Laidback Manly is one of Sydney's most popular beaches. A 30 minute ferry ride across Sydney Harbour will get you there, and you won't want to leave with a pick of both the surf and a quieter inner harbour beach. When you're looking to wind things down though, just 45 minutes north of the city is Narrabeen. The coastal hideaway has plenty of fun both on and off the water.

West Sydney

Soak up the history and vibrancy of Sydney's west. Once host of the 2000 Olympics, Homebush Bay's Sydney Olympic Park is now an urban waterfront parkland. Keep an eye out for festivals, concerts and events held here throughout the year.

Beyond Olympic Park, it's easy to see why Parramatta is often called 'Sydney's Living Museum', with its colonial architecture, historic sites, elegant parks and a huge array of international restaurants and cafés. Further west, take a self drive tour of Penrith Valley in the Blue Mountains foothills. It's an aquatic adventure playground with plenty of sports, entertainment and cultural options, not to mention easy access to the Blue Mountains.

Our Favourite Experiences

The Classics

Sydney Harbour is the epicentre of Sydney. Your day is easily filled and you'll come back for more when you get a taste of the holiday fun at your feet. Get out and feel the wind in your sails on a harbour cruise, see the harbour at breakneck speed from a jet boat, or take a slower pace with a kayak around secret coves and beaches. Off the water, saddle up and cycle around the harbour foreshores.

No trip to Sydney is complete without seeing the unmistakable Sydney Opera House. You can walk around it, take a backstage tour, or see a performance, but be sure to enjoy a drink at the Opera Bar with the iconic structure as a backdrop. The Opera House sits alongside another of Sydney's gems – the Harbour Bridge. Celebrate this famous Sydney landmark with a visit to the fun and free Sydney Harbour Bridge Visitor Centre. For sensational views, the Pylon Lookout is well worth the 200 steps, and it's great value. Or take the climb to the very summit of the bridge.

Shopping

Lovers of shopping, Sydney's for you. Whether you're out for a bargain or a one-off find, prepare yourself for endless options in Sydney. Start in the city heart where you'll find the Queen Victoria Building (QVB), Strand Arcade, Pitt Street Mall and the new Westfield Sydney. Oxford Street in Paddington is known as the Style Mile – it's all about galleries, home wares and designer boutiques. For high class fashion, Double Bay is the place to go.

Ready for the bargains? Bohemian meets retro fashion in Newtown, while King Street is right up there for vintage shoes and bags. There are factory outlets at Birkenhead Point Outlet Centre and Sydney Olympic Park. Or seek out Chinatown and Surry Hills for discount stores. Market culture is alive and well in Sydney. On the weekends, visit The Rocks, Paddington, Bondi, Manly, Glebe and Balmain for some of the best.

Family Fun

From a day at the Sydney Aquarium to the thrill of a movie in the IMAX Theatre, kids just love Sydney. Take the family to see the sights at Darling Harbour including the Powerhouse Museum or Australian National Maritime Museum where the kids can get in and play. Then be whizzed off in the monorail to take on the city.

For a fix of cute and cuddly wildlife encounters, head to Wildlife World or take the ferry across the harbour from the

city to Taronga Zoo. If rides and amusements are more their scene, Luna Park is a must. And the older kids will love the speed of a jet boat or thrill of a bridge climb.

The whole family will love a day at Moore Park. Spend the morning shopping before lunch and a round of mini golf. Keep the activities going at Sydney Olympic Park where you can hire bikes, have a barbecue or visit the aquatic centre. A Sydney holiday is a kid's wildest dream.
